



Convention on the shelter and life of disaster victims
In Nanzih District, Kaohsiung City
Update on Response to COVID-19 Precautions

In response to COVID-19 pandemic , this precaution has been updated according to the Guidance on temporary shelters for victims in response to outbreak of COVID-19 compiled by the Social Work Department of the Ministry of Health and Welfare in 2020 .

1. During the opening of the shelter , people should take their body temperature before entering the shelter and wear a mask throughout the process.
2. Please cooperate with daily body temperature measurement and self-health monitoring in the morning and evening. If you have fever (ear temperature $\geq 38^{\circ}\text{C}$; forehead temperature $\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$) , respiratory symptoms, abnormal smell and taste or diarrhea, etc., you should take the initiative to report to the staff and cooperate with appropriate precautions and medical attention.
3. A social distance of 1.5 meters indoors and 1 meter outdoors in the shelters . Social distancing is exempt if both parties wear masks correctly.
4. People at the same table should maintain a social distance of 1.5 meters as much as possible or cooperate with partitions and screens for separation during meals. When necessary, cooperate with time-sharing meals. Avoid talking when eating at the table, and wear a mask when you want to talk after eating.
5. All sheltered residents should wear masks at all times, except resting in their beds.
6. The sheltered residents should pay attention to hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette.
