

Airport Fever Screening Incentive Program for Incoming Passengers



Those who enter from dengue fever-endemic areas and have symptoms will receive a **NT\$500** gift voucher

by completing the epidemic survey and blood draw at Kaohsiung International Airport and waiting for the results and cooperating with all the following measures:



- 1** Passengers must wait at the airport referral station until test results are available.
- 2** Passengers must complete the dengue fever investigation form in full at the referral station.
- 3** Passengers advised to be hospitalized until PCR test results are released will receive an additional NT\$1,000 gift voucher.
- 4** Passengers admitted to Kaohsiung Municipal Siaogang Hospital or Kaohsiung Municipal Min-Sheng Hospital will have their airport taxi fare reimbursed upon verification. Not hospitalized passengers must allow the local health center to visit their residence by the next day to conduct a preventive breeding source inspection.

Incentive for Voluntary Symptom Monitoring and Reporting by Incoming Passengers :

Kaohsiung City residents with suspected dengue fever symptoms who voluntarily report to the city's health authorities within **2** days of entry and cooperate with subsequent preventive measures—such as testing, reporting, and epidemiological investigations—will receive a **NT\$500** epidemic prevention gift voucher. If dengue fever is confirmed, the Kaohsiung City Health Bureau will award an additional **NT\$2,500** reporting incentive.

Incentive for Voluntary Symptom Monitoring and Reporting by Incoming Passengers :



Foreign tourists in tour groups with suspected dengue fever symptoms, who are assisted by an international tour leader or guide to seek medical treatment, testing, and epidemiological investigation within **2** days of entry, and agree to be hospitalized until the PCR test results are available, will receive free hospitalization (the subsidy excludes meal expenses and self-paid ward fees) until the PCR test results are released and be awarded a **NT\$1,000** gift voucher.

Tour guides/leader were originally awarded a **NT\$500** gift voucher in 2024, which has been increased to an **NT\$1,000** epidemic prevention gift voucher.

may collect a care package from local health centers before departure, and by voluntarily undergoing testing at a city health center within **2** days of entry, will be awarded a **NT\$500** epidemic prevention gift voucher.
